RADIO NUMBER OF SOME WHEEL RELATED GRAPHS

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For a graph G and any two vertices u and v in G, let d(u,v) denote the distance between them and let diam(G) be the diameter of G. A multilevel distance labeling (or radio labeling) for G is a function f that assigns to each vertex of G a positive integer such that for any two distinct vertices u and v, $d(u,v) + |f(u) - f(v)| \ge diam(G) + 1$. The largest integer in the range of f is called the span of f and is denoted f. The radio number of G, denoted rn(G), is the minimum span of any radio labeling for G. In this paper the radio numbers of ome wheel related graphs are determined.
